3. **LICENCE OUT 30 SHOPS IN BUDH BAZAR MARKET FOR THE PURPOSE OF BUSINESS EXCEPT NON-VEGETARIAN AND INTOXICATION ITEMS THROUGH PUBLIC AUCTION.**

Reference: CBR No.23 dated 18-12-2015.

To reconsider the minimum reserve price as well as amount of security deposit for licensing out 30 shops in Budh Bazar market for the purpose of general business except non-vegetarian and intoxication items through public auction.

It is informed to the Board that the Board vide its CBR No. 13 dated 08/05/2015 read with CBR No. 09 dated 06/07/2015 has fixed the Reserve Licence Fee per month per shop Rs. 2000/- for shop No. 1 to 5 & shop No. 7 to 30 and Rs. 1750/- for shop No. 6 for the purpose of public auction. Accordingly, all the 30 shops were put to auction and 06 shops were got auctioned through public auction held on 24/06/2015 approved by the Board vide its CBR No. 13 dated 06/07/2015. After sometime, all licensees have vacated the shops by stating that they are going into loss as there is not so business in the shops and they are hardly recovering the amount of license fees and other expenses.

Meanwhile, Vice-president Smt. Sushila Devi alongwith other elected members have submitted an application dated 12/12/2015 which was presented before the Board in its meeting held on 18/12/2015 regarding re-consider the licence fee and amount of security deposit approved by the Board vide CBR No. 13 dated 08/05/2015 read with CBR No. 09 dated 06/07/2015. They stated that the public is not interested to do business in the shops because the Security Money as well as monthly licence fees is higher. The Board vide its CBR referred to above have considered the matter and resolved to fix the Minimum Reserve Price of Rs. 1500/- for shop No. 1 to 5 & shop No. 7 to 30 and Minimum Reserve Price of Rs. 1200/- for shop No. 6 as a license fees for the purpose of public auction. The Board has also resolved that there shall be no change in the security amount. Accordingly, the auction for licensing out all 30 shops was called on 27/02/2016 and only 02 shops could be licensed out in the auction which was approved by the Board vide its CBR No.04 dated 30/03/2016. After some time 01 licensee has also vacated the shop and at present only 01 shop is on license and remaining 29 shops are lying vacant.

The details of amount of security deposit reserve license fee and electricity charges as approved by the Board vide its CBR referred to above alongwith shop number and area thereof is given below :-

It is further informed to the Board that, while vacating the shops, most of the licensees have stated that the amount of Security Deposit, Monthly License Fees along with other charges are higher and they are not able to recover the monthly expenses and because of that they are going into loss.

Thus it is seen that auctions were called two times but the shops are still lying vacant which is resulting into loss of revenue of the Board.

In this connection the report of Revenue Inspector (Offg.) dated 08/03/2017 alongwith concerned file is placed on the table.

Therefore, the Board may decide suitable action in the matter.

3. **RESOLUTION:** - The Board considered the matter in detail and unanimously resolved to re-fix the minimum reserve price of Rs. 1000.00 per shop per month for Shop No. 1 to 5 & Shop No. 7 to 30 and minimum reserve price of Rs. 800.00 for Shop No. 6 per month as a licence fees for the purpose and also resolved to fix the Security Money of Rs. 25,000.00 for each Shop. The Board further resolved that the shops be auctioned accordingly.

4. **MOBILIZATION OF RESOURCES OF CANTT. BOARD BABINA- REVISION OF NON TAX REVENUE**

To consider and approve the revision of Non Tax fees/charges for the purpose of augmentation/mobilization of income of the Board under section 67 of Cantonment Acts, 2006.

It is informed to the Board that in order to augment/mobilize the revenue of the Board, the following fees/charges levied u/s 67 of Cantonments Act, 2006 need to be further revised. The existing and proposed rates are as under:-

The Board further resolved that a Report for collection of Licence fees for Hoarding/Sign Board during the financial year 2016-17 be placed before the Board in the next meeting for perusal of the Board.

5. **REVIEW OF ESTABLISHMENT: TOLL BARRIERS**

Reference: CBR No. 11 dated 18/12/2015.

To consider the question of continuation of closing of Toll Post No. 01 situated Near Quarters of Forest Department on N. H.26.

It is informed to the Board that the Board vide its CBR referred to above had closed one Toll post situated on National Highway 26 w.e.f. 01/02/2016 for the period of one year to watch the collection of toll tax instead of two toll posts. The said period has already expired on 31/01/2017.

In this connection it is also informed to the Board that the average collection from one toll post was approximately in comparison of collections from both these toll posts. Details of collection from two toll posts and one toll post as shown in the Annexure-"A" is placed on the table for perusal of the Board.

It is further informed to the Board that the rights for collection of Toll Tax from Toll post No 2 Situated Near Indira Gandhi Statue on N.H. 26 of Babina Cantonment has been licensed out through contract to M/s Neha Traders, 208 Shastri Nagar, Babina for a period of one year i.e. 21/12/2016 to 20/12/2017 vide CBR No. 4 dated 14/10/2016.

Therefore it is proposed to continue of closing Toll Post No. 1 situated Near Quarters of Forest Department on N.H. 26 for a further period of one year i.e. 01/02/2017 to 31/01/2018.

In this connection, all relevant documents alongwith concerned file and report of Toll Inspector (Offg.) are placed on the table.

Therefore the Board may decide action in the matter.

5. **RESOLUTION:** - The Board considered the matter in detail and unanimously resolved to close the Toll Barrier situated on National Highway No. 26 for a further period of one year i.e. up to 31/01/2018. The Board further resolved that surplus staff of toll section be deputed where ever necessary in the office or somewhere else.
6. **REVISION OF PAY SCALES OF CANTONMENT FUND EMPLOYEES W.E.F. 01.01.2016 AT PAR WITH U.P. STATE GOVT. AS PER RECOMMENDATIONS OF 7TH PAY COMMISSION OF UTTAR PRADESH GOVERNMENT.**

To consider and approve the revised pay scales of the Cantonment Fund Employees of Babina Cantonment at par with U.P. State Govt. Recommendations of 7th Pay Commission of U.P. (2016) sanctioned by the U.P. State Govt. to their employees w.e.f. 1st January 2016 vide their G.O. No. 67/2016/Ve. Aa-2-1447/Dus-04(M)/2016 dated 22nd December 2016 & vide G.O. No. 66/2016/Ve. 7. **REVISION OF PENSION/FAMILY PENSION OF CANTT. FUND PENSIONERS OF BABINA CANTT. AT PAR WITH RECOMMENDATIONS OF SEVENTH PAY COMMISSION OF U.P. 2016 WEF. 01.01.2016**

Reference UP State Government Order No.39/2016-Sa-3-923/Dus-216-308/2016 dated 23.12.2016.

To consider and approve the revised pension/family pension of Cantonment Fund Pensioner/Family Pensioners of Babina Cantonment as per recommendation of Seventh Pay Commission of Uttar Pradesh 2016 and sanction of the UP State Government vide Order No.39/2016-Sa-3-923/Dus-216-308/2016 dated 23.12.2016 are as under :-

- (i) Existing pensioner/Existing Family pensioners means a pensioner/family pensioner, who drawing pension/family pension on 31.12.2015.
- (ii) Existing Pension/Existing Family Pension means the basic pension (inclusive of commuted portion, if any) or basic family pension, which are applicable on 31.12.2015
- (iii) For existing pensioners, who have been retired before 01.01.2016, the revised pension/family pension with effect from 01.01.2016 shall b4e determined by multiplying the pension/family pension by 2.57. The amount of revised pension/family pension so arrived at shall be rounded off to next higher rupee.
- (iv) The minimum pension with effect from 01.01.2016 will be Rs. 9000/- per month (excluding additional pension, which is granted to the 80 years or above pensioners). The upper ceiling on pension/family pension will be 50% & 30% respectively of the highest pay in Government.
- (v) The quantum of pension/family pension available to old pensioners/family pensioners shall continue to be as follows :-

Age of pensioner/family pensioner	Additional quantum of pension
From 80 years to less than 85 years	20% of revised basic pension/family pension.
From 85 years to less than 90 years	30% of revised basic pension/family pension.
From 90 years to less than 95 years	40% of revised basic pension/family pension.
From 95 years to less than 100 years	50% of revised basic pension/family pension.
From 100 years or more	100% of revised basic pension/family pension.

- (vi) Where the revised pension/family pension in terms of para-4 of said order work out to an amount less than Rs. 9000/-, the same shall be stepped up to Rs. 9000/-.This will be regarded as pension/family pension with effect from 01.01.2016.

- (vii) The pension/family pension as worked out in accordance with provisions of para-4 and 7 of the ibid order shall be treated as 'Basic Pension' with effect from 01.01.2016. The dearness relief shall be applicable from time to time to the revised pension/family pension. Under these orders, payment of dearness relief to revised pension/family pension @ of 0% and 2% w.e.f. 01.01.2016 and 01.07.2016 respectively shall be paid.

It is informed to the Board that as per Rule 31 of the CFSR 1937 the provisions of Central Civil Services (Pension) Rules 1972 as amended from time to time, shall, mutatis-mutandis, govern the grant of Pension, Family Pension and Death-cum-Retirement Gratuity to the eligible servants and as per memorandum of settlement the pay and allowance is being provided to the employees of Cantonment Board Babina at par with State Government of Uttar Pradesh.

It is further informed to the Board that the PDDE, SC, Pune vide letter No.2117/Pension/GEN/XXXIII/DE dated 26.03.2009 has directed to this office regarding revision of pension/family pension w.e.f. 01.01.2006 in Cantonment Board Babina that 'this Dte. vide letter No.2117/Pension/Gen/XXII/DE dated 22.03.2007 has already clarified that as and when State Government concerned issue the sanction to its retired/retiring employee, the same is also automatically be made applicable to the concerned retired Cantonment Board employees and no separate sanction is necessary.

Accordingly, this office vide Officer Order No.80 dated 28.04.2009 revised the pension/family pension w.e.f. 01.01.2006 on the recommendation of Sixth Pay Commission and as per UP Govt. Order.

In this connection, all relevant papers/documents alongwith UP Govt. G.O. are placed for perusal please.
